Introduction

Year in Review

Thanks to you, our Kasisi children have had yet another **wonderful year**. Even though the number of children has increased, with your support we have been able to provide them with a true Home, care, education, and food. The numbers are impressive – our kitchen has been working at full capacity, preparing **over 1,000 meals per day!**



Numbers

Over the past year, **255 children** lived at Kasisi, including **35 newcomers**.

Six children were adopted, and **39 returned** to live with their families.

Funds Transferred to Kasisi

In 2023, the value of assistance provided to Kasisi and the foundation's beneficiaries amounted to **€531,322.05**.

Most of the needs of the Kasisi Children's Home were met thanks to the **wonderful support** from the **"Adoptions from the Heart" program – €493,886.48**.





How We Used the Donations

Drought at Kasisi

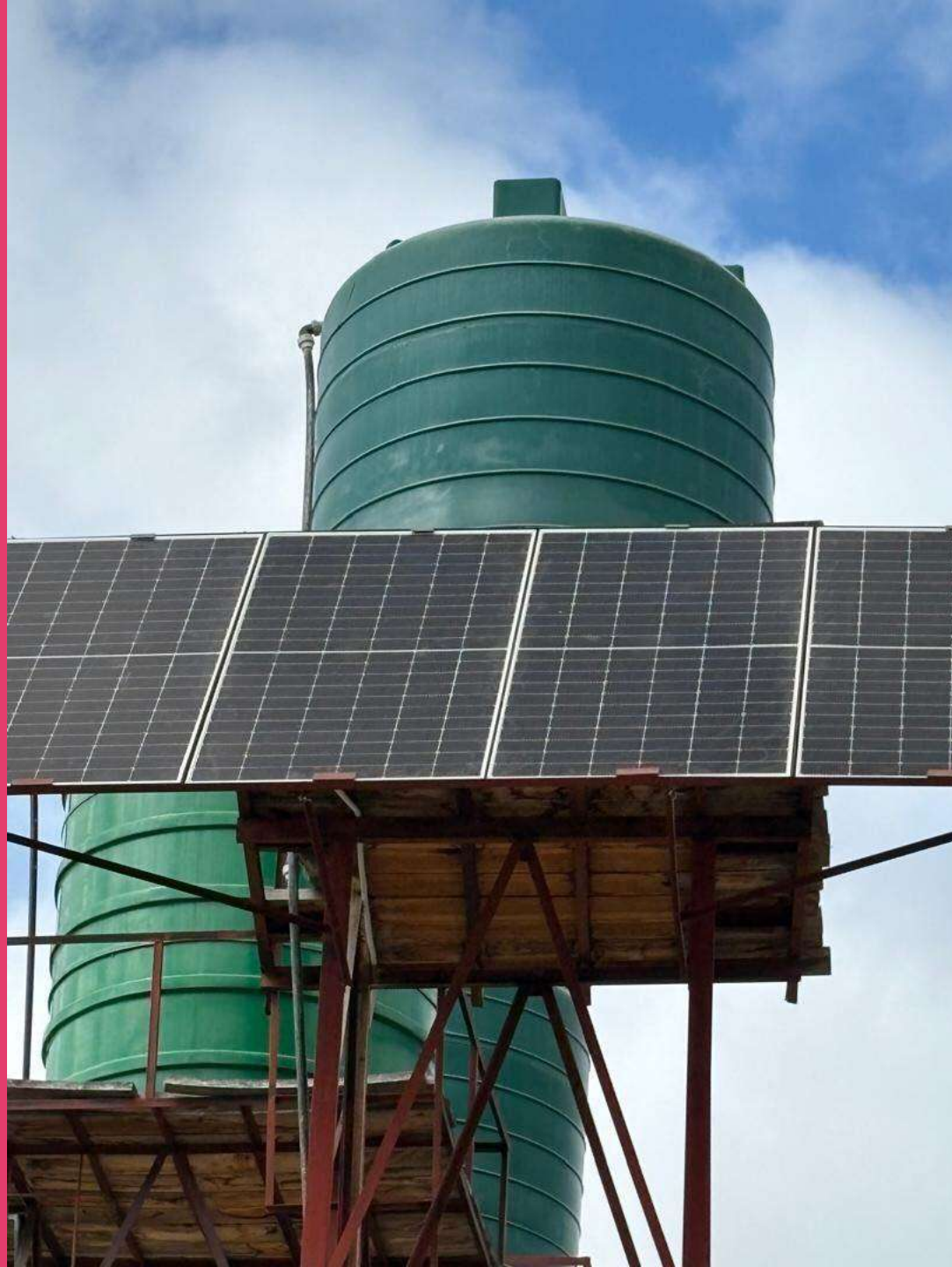
In March 2024, Zambia faced a severe drought. Lack of rainfall not only threatened agriculture but also caused **power outages** — lasting **up to 8 hours a day**.

For the Kasisi Children's Home, this was an enormous **challenge**. Without electricity, it's impossible to **cook meals**, conduct **classes** or **provide medical care** for the children.

That's why we asked for help to purchase **fuel for the generators** — the only source of power when the grid fails. Thanks to your support, we raised **€14,340**.

This support gave us safety, uninterrupted care, and peaceful sleep for the children.

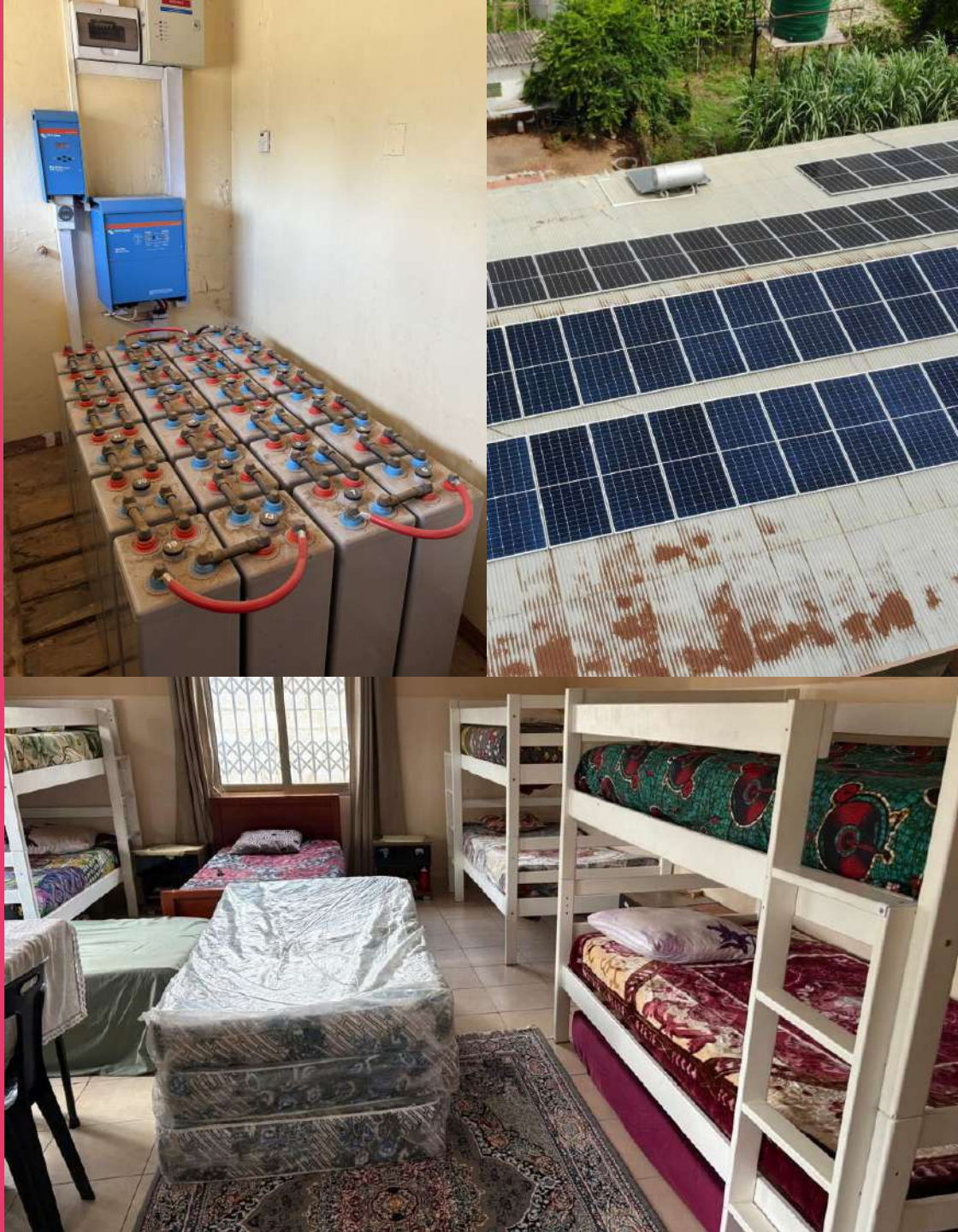
Energy Crisis in Zambia

The deepening **energy crisis** forced us to look for long-term solutions. To avoid relying on generators and expensive fuel, we decided to invest in **solar installations for the entire Kasisi**.

In December, we launched a **special fundraiser for this purpose**.

Thanks to your support, we began **installing solar panels on key buildings**. We started with the kitchen. In 2025, we plan to continue with the laundry building and the facilities that provide children with basic care and education.

This is a step toward **full energy independence**, ensuring Kasisi's stability even in the most difficult conditions.



How We Used the Donations

Important Investments at Kasisi

Your support helped us take care of the comfort and safety of the children at Kasisi.

Thanks to you, in 2024:

- **We renovated the wing of the Home dedicated to the youngest children**, creating a cozy and safe space for them.
- **We created a new banana garden** to enrich the children's diet with fresh fruit.
- **We installed 3 new solar water heaters** to provide the children with constant access to hot water.
- **We purchased new wooden cribs for the little ones**, ensuring peaceful sleep and healthy development.
- **We furnished House of Mercy** (home of the oldest girls) and the boys' houses **with new beds, mattresses, and furniture**, improving the quality of life for our oldest residents.

Thanks to you, the children have not only a safe home, but also better conditions to grow and thrive.

Fundraiser for Prosthetics

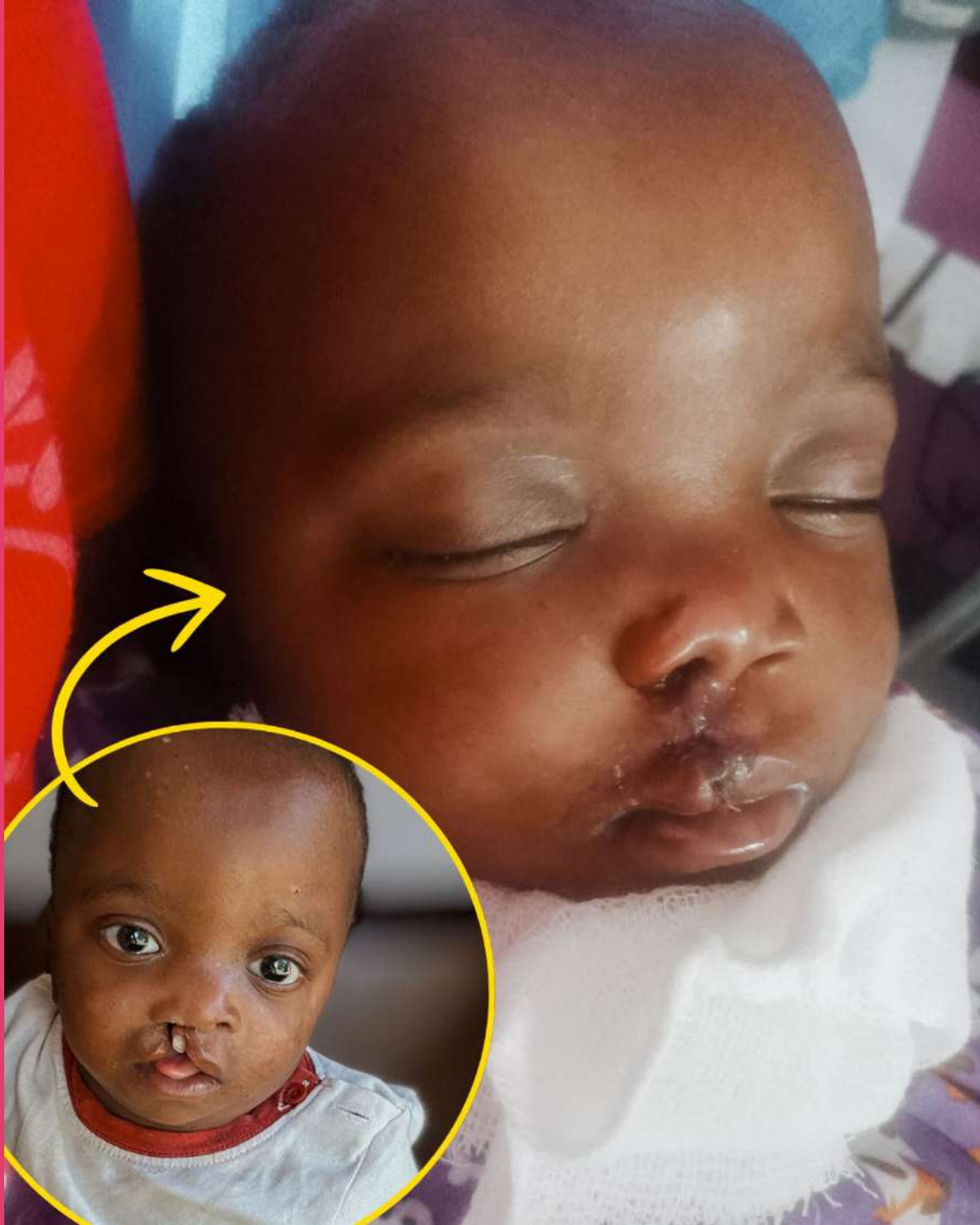
Children with albinism in many African countries live under constant threat. Superstitions, belief in the “magical power” of their bodies, and greed make them victims of brutal attacks. At Kasisi, seven such children have found refuge from violence.

Today, they have a chance to live without pain and shame. All they need are **prosthetics**—ones that **must be regularly replaced** as the children grow.

That’s not possible in Zambia. That’s why Sister Mariola travels with them to the USA, where specially fitted, advanced prosthetics are made.

In March 2024, we asked for **€13,600** to fund this. We raised an incredible **€75,830**.

The surplus was used to support the education and medical care for children with albinism.



How We Used the Donations

Gift's Health

Gift was born with a severe **cleft palate**.

Instead of enjoying a carefree childhood, he had to **fight for every gram of weight** from the very beginning. Because of the defect, he couldn't eat normally — and without **reaching 6 kilograms**, surgery was out of the question.

Together with you, we fought for that goal. Thanks to every package of **porridge**, every **can of formula**, **every donation** and **every prayer** — Gift **gained enough weight** and **underwent the surgery** that is changing his life.

Your support covered all the care he needed before and after his operation. Today, he sleeps peacefully — healthy, safe, and well-fed.

How We Used the Donations

Education

Thanks to the support of our Donors, **we were able to provide education for all children and youth from Kasisi** — from preschoolers to university students. We covered school fees and boarding costs, as well as the **cost of textbooks, 150 uniforms, and 200 pairs of school shoes.**

In 2024, the funds we sent made it possible to provide education for:

- **55** preschoolers
- **80** primary school students
- **30** high school students
- **7** college students
- **3** university students



How We Used the Donations

Eva Medical Student

Eva is currently in her sixth and final year of medical studies at the Collegium Medicum of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń. We financed her **tuition**, purchased **textbooks**, and covered Eva's **basic living expenses**.

She passes all her exams on the first attempt.

Now, she's preparing for the challenging **final medical exam** — we're keeping our fingers crossed for her!

Thanks to You, in 2024 we made the following dreams come true:

- **14 children went on an unforgettable four-day trip to Victoria Falls.**
- **We organized a special bonfire evening** full of fun, dancing, and roasting sausages under the stars.
- **We prepared memorable holiday celebrations,** creating a joyful atmosphere with presents and shared festivities.
- **We invited the children to the cinema** and took them on exciting **educational trips**, including a visit to a crocodile farm, to enrich their experiences and bring them joy.

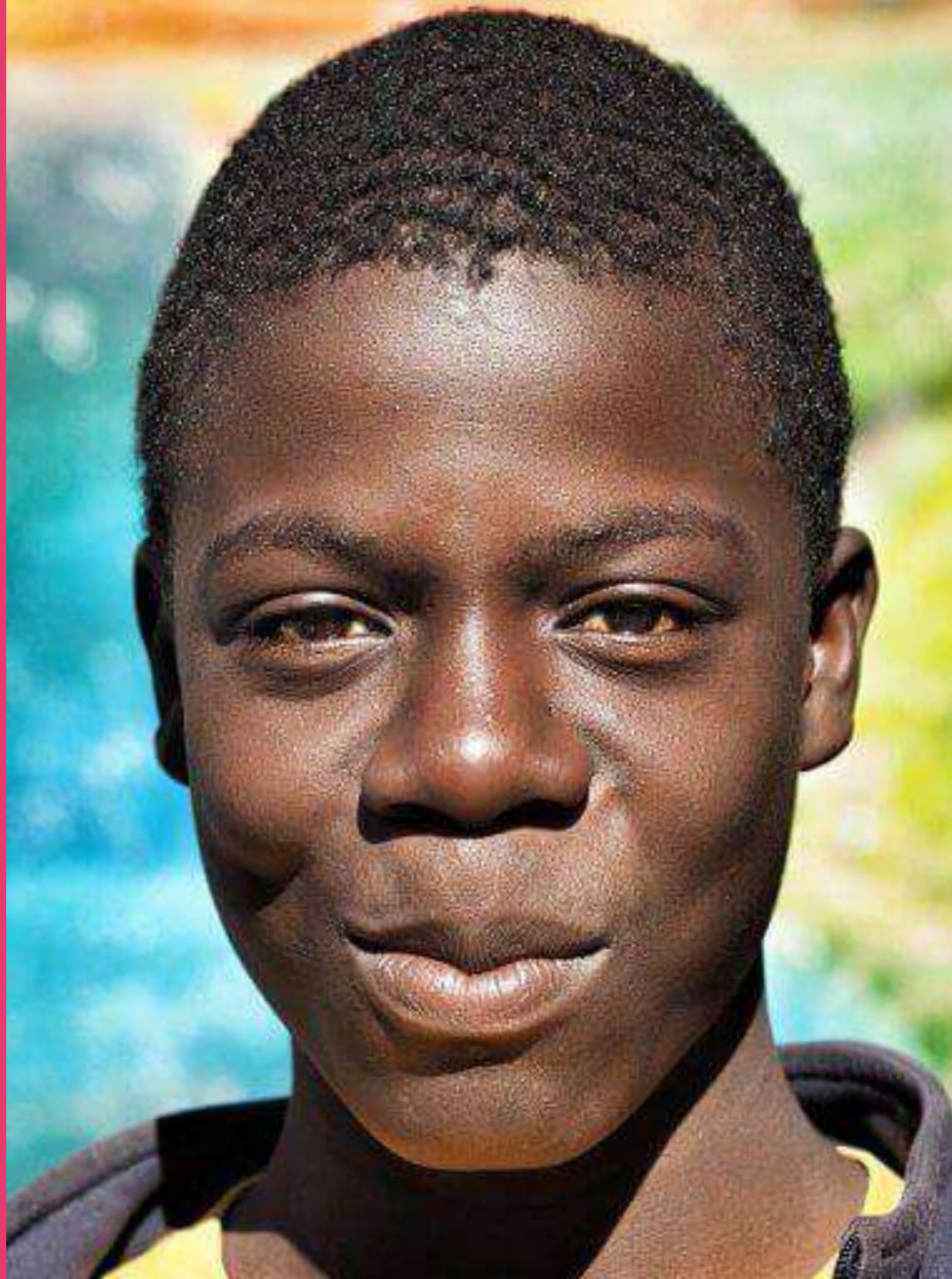

How We Used the Donations

Helping Outside

Many people struggle with **hunger** and **poverty**. Sometimes impoverished Zambians knock on Kasisi's doors, **asking for basic assistance**. We never refuse to share food with anyone.

We also helped **cover the cost of education and school supplies** for around 40 children from different parts of Zambia.



How We Used the Donations

Christopher Sakala Memorial Fund

Through the Christopher Sakala Memorial Fund, we have **provided care for 12 patients** in the Oncology Department at the hospital in Lusaka. The funds collected allowed us to purchase medications, dressings, food, clothing, toys for children, as well as to cover chemotherapy costs and transportation back home after hospitalization. Additionally, we assisted the families of deceased children with funeral arrangements.

Additionally, we covered the travel costs to India for two young patients to receive specialized medical treatment.

Who Was Christopher Sakala

Sister Mariola, who fought for Christopher's life when he was undergoing cancer treatment in the hospital, witnessed very difficult situations. She saw the poverty and suffering of children with cancer, who receive nothing but a bowl of porridge three times a day. Most parents cannot afford treatment. In memory of Christopher, we established a fund that continues to operate today, supporting the cancer treatment of other children.
